The Transformation Technician / Policy Analyst is a full-time term position which will work collaboratively with the Weechi-it-te-win Family Services Abinoojii Inakonigewin advisory team, member First Nations and other key stakeholders.

The Transformation Technician / Policy Analyst must be passionate about implementing innovative change consistent with First Nation jurisdiction and the overall vision of Weechi-it-te-win Family Services.

The Transformation Technician/Policy Analyst must be knowledgeable in all aspects of the culture, Anishinaabe child rearing practices and the child and family service system.

The Transformation Technician / Policy Analyst will provide technical support and advice, will conduct research, coordinate engagement sessions, and write various communiques, briefings, reports, and internal policies. This contractor must have excellent communication skills. The position will balance office and community-based work activities.

Applicants with the following qualifications will be considered:

- University degree in social work, public policy, community development, First Nation self-government or related field or equivalent experience.
- Two (2) years' experience working with First Nation communities or organizations.
- Knowledge of Anishinaabe child rearing practices.
- Demonstrated facilitation and presentation skills.
- Excellent oral and written communication skills.
- Strong computer skills with proficiency in Microsoft Office Programs.
- Excellent research and writing skills.
- Keen political acuity in providing strategic advice and making recommendations to partners and stakeholders.
- Task oriented with the ability to manage multiple priorities and work in a fast-paced environment.
- Proven project and team management skills
- Ability to understand and speak Anishinaabemowin is a definite asset.
